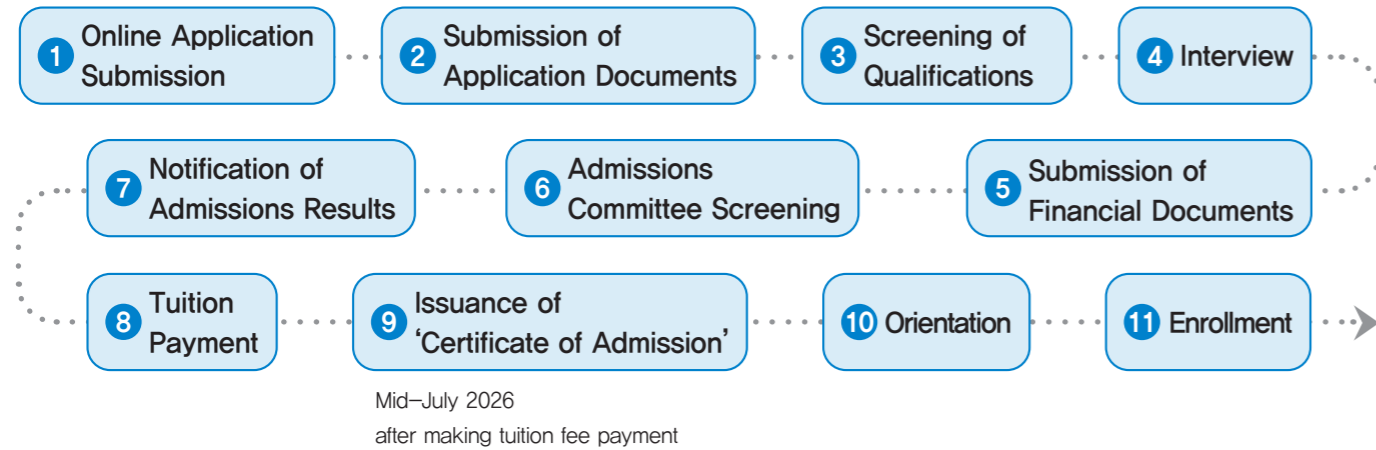

※ NOTES

- ① Most courses in the Undergraduate Program are conducted in Korean, but some classes are taught in English.
- ② School of Architecture (Major in Architecture) is a 5-year program.
- ③ Students who are enrolled in the Department of Civil Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering (Platform Software, Data Science), Computer Science and Engineering (Computing), Agricultural Civil Engineering, Agricultural Civil & Bio-industrial Engineering or Smart Bio-Industrial Mechanical Engineering must complete the ABEEK (Accreditation Board for Engineering Education of Korea) program. Transfer students may take one or two semesters longer depending on their ABEEK requirements.
- ④ The Departments of Music, Design, and Fine Arts accept new students in the spring semester only.
- ⑤ The Department of History Education at the Teachers College can admit up to 20% of the enrollment quota in accordance with the Ministry of Education's (Guidelines for Operating Teacher Training Institutions Beyond the Quota).
- ⑥ Preliminary successful candidates for the Local Special Admission, KNU's Korean Language Program Preliminary Admission, or Transfer Preliminary Admission can only apply to the department they have been accepted into.
- ⑦ Any future changes to department names or recruitment units will be updated in the admissions guidelines.

4 Eligibility

〈Nationality Requirement for both Regular(Non-Transfer) and Transfer Students〉

- Applicants and both of their parents must be non-Korean nationals.
- * Nationality criterion is evidenced only if applicants and both of their parents acquire non-Korean nationality by the time the applicant begins the curriculum corresponding to the educational programs of Korean high schools.
- Multi-nationals with Korean citizenship are not eligible.
- Eligible Nationality Status must be established before the application due date.

1. Regular(Non-Transfer) Admissions

- ▶ He or she must have completed his or her entire elementary and junior high school education and; he or she must have completed including students expected to graduate in August 2026 high school education at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea.
- ※ Applicants who have completed home schooling, cyber learning, or taken qualification exams in Korea or abroad (e.g GED) during their 12 years of primary education are NOT eligible for enrollment.

- Applicants should complete all formal education in ONE country.
- Applicants who have studied in more than 2 countries should complete 12 years of education.
 - Applicants who have completed less than 11 years should apply for high school as a Regular or transfer within Korea or overseas.
 - In the case of 11–year foreign systems (see chart above), applicants should complete the last 3 years of education in ONE country in order to acquire high school qualification.
 - For students with unfinished years due to a gap in their education system, the period of years at an overseas university will be counted as equivalent to Korean high school years.

Criteria for Qualification of High School Graduation

- High school graduation should be completed by the day prior to the opening day of admission to KNU in order to qualify. However, for applicants from countries in which the academic year and the opening day of school differ by more than one (1) month from Korea (e.g., Japan), one (1) full month of attendance at an overseas high school will be approved as equivalent to graduation.

2. Transfer Admissions (3rd Year)

- ▶ Graduated or about to graduate before August 2026 from a 2 or 3–year accredited college or completed at least two years (4 semesters) of a 4–year university program (over 65 credit hours).

※ NOTES

- 1) You can apply only with the same or similar major as the university major you studied.
- 2) Those who have completed two years at a 3–year university are not eligible.
- 3) Those who graduated from a university that does not have a credit system are not eligible.
- 4) Those who are enrolled at KNU cannot apply for transfer admission.
- 5) Applicants who have completed home schooling, cyber learning, or taken qualification exams in Korea or abroad during their entire education period are NOT eligible for enrollment.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Transfer Applicants: Level 4 TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Certificate (or higher)

※ Applicants who have taken the 105th or 106th TOPIK may apply using their test registration slip; however, a score of Level 4 or higher must be submitted by June 26, 2026(Fri) 1:00pm.

※ The Department of Business Administration will recognize only language proficiency test scores submitted by May 7, 2026 (Thu) 6:00pm

B. Regular(Non–Transfer) Applicants: Among applicants for Regular(Non–Transfer) admission, those applying to the 23 departments (A) listed in <Table 1. Minimum Language Proficiency Requirements by Department> must meet the Eligibility for Language Proficiency (B) specified for each department. Applicants applying to departments not listed in <Table 1> must satisfy at least one of the language proficiency criteria (①–⑤) below.

※ Only accepted if completion date is by May 7, 2026 (Thu) 6:00pm.

※ KNU Korean Language Program Students submit a Certificate of Completion by May 13, 2026 (Wed).

③ Applicants can submit an English score report from a recognized English proficiency test (e.g., TOEFL iBT 59, IELTS 5.5, NEW TEPS 202, CEFR B2 or higher).

※ Only accepted if date of receiving score is before May 7, 2026 (Thu) 6:00pm.

※ Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland).

④ Those who have completed Level 3 or higher of the Ministry of Justice Korea Immigration and Integration Program (KIIP) or have obtained a score of 61 or higher on the preliminary test.

⑤ Those who submit a certificate of completion for the Basic Korean Language Course (Intermediate 1 level or higher) issued by an overseas Sejong Institute. (Certificates from online Sejong Institute courses are not accepted.)

C. Preliminary successful candidates of the Local Special Admission, KNU’s Korean Language Program Preliminary Admission, or Transfer Preliminary Admission must submit the required language proficiency test scores specified by their applied department no later than June 26, 2026 (Fri) 1:00pm

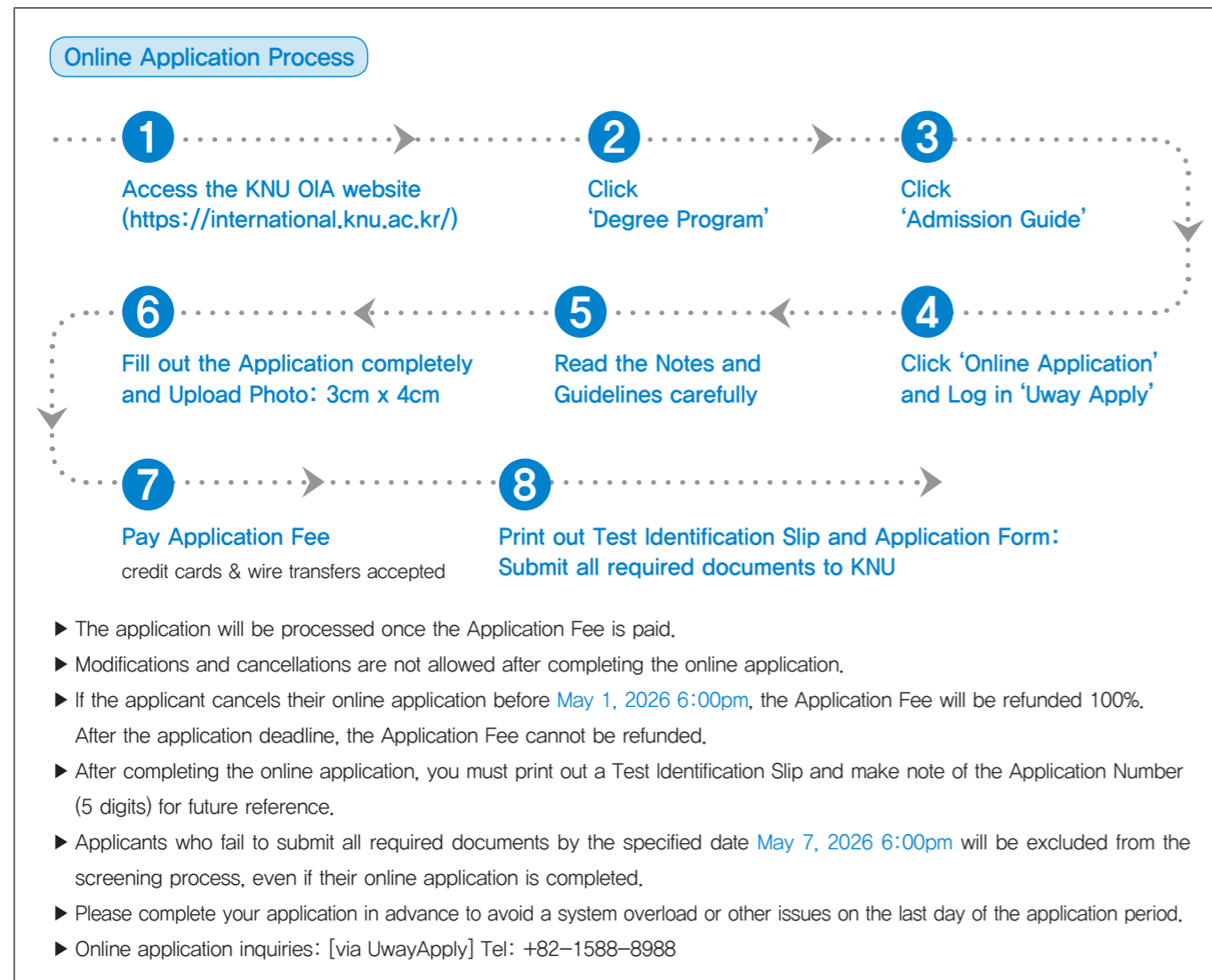

5 Application Procedure

1. Applications

A. Online Application Period: April 13, 2026 (Mon) 9:00am ~ May 1, 2026 (Fri) 6:00pm

- ① Online Application Site: KNU OIA website (<http://international.knu.ac.kr>) – Degree Program – International Special Admissions – Undergraduate – Online Application – UwayApply (www.uwayapply.com)
- ② You will receive an Application Number after completing the Online Application.



B. Submission of Application Documents

- ① Submission Period : **April 13, 2026 (Mon) 9:00am ~ May 7, 2026 (Thu) 6:00pm**
- ② Where to Submit: Office of International Affairs (첨성인미래관 Cheomseongin Student Futures Support Bldg 2nd Fl.)
- ③ How to Submit: After completing the online application, print the admission application form and submit it along with the required documents listed under "[6] Required Documents." (Financial documents must be submitted after passing the interview and oral examination.)

2. Qualification Screening

A. Screening Period: May 8, 2026 (Fri) ~ May 19, 2026 (Tue)

B. Screening Method: Examination of the suitability of applicants' academic background and language proficiency, so as to be deemed "qualified" or "unqualified."

3. Interview

A. Interview Period: May 20, 2026 (Wed) ~ June 5, 2026 (Fri) expected

B. Interviews will be conducted by the Office of International Affairs at KNU.

(Notes: The performance test for applicants to the College of Arts will be conducted by each respective department, and applicants to the Department of Fine Arts must participate in the on-site practical test.)

C. Interview Method: Online interview (e.g., Zoom, etc.)

– Applicants will be individually notified of the date and Zoom link for their interview.

※ Preliminary successful candidates of the Local Special Admission, KNU's Korean Language Program Preliminary Admission, or the Transfer Preliminary Admission's special admission are exempt from the oral interview.

- ① All required documents must be submitted in person or by post.
- ② All submitted documents must be written in either Korean or English. If documents are in another language, a notarized translation must be provided.
- ③ For English copies of documents, a notarized Certified True Copy by a Notary Public must be submitted.
- ④ All required documents must be submitted in the order of the list above. (Do not use staplers, clips, etc.)

- If one of the applicant's parents has remarried a Korean national, an additional certificate (e.g., Family Relation Certificate, Resident Registration Certificate, etc.) is required to further establish the applicant's relationship to the parents.
- ⑦ Prospective Graduates: Certificate of (Expected) Graduation: At the time of application, applicants must submit a Certificate of Expected Graduation (indicating the expected date of graduation) issued by their school. However, once admitted, they must submit an official Certificate of Graduation (original and notarized) and academic verification documents (for China – CHSI certificate; for countries other than China – Apostille or embassy certification) to the Office of International Affairs by August 28, 2026 (Fri). Transcript: At the time of application, applicants must submit an official transcript including all grades earned up to the application deadline. After graduation, the final transcript must be submitted to the Office of International Affairs by August 21, 2026 (Fri).
 - ⑧ Preliminary Successful Applicants: Only students who have been preliminarily accepted must submit the previously issued "Preliminary Notice of Acceptance" along with their application documents.
 - ⑨ Passport: The passport expiration date must be after the semester start date.
 - ※ Applicants with Uzbek nationality must submit a new passport that is valid for overseas travel.
 - ⑩ Documents in other languages must be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation. Certificates must be notarized within 6 months prior to submission.

2. Financial Documents

- A. Relevant Applicants: Applicants who pass the Interview
- B. Submission Period: From announcement date of the Interview result By June 19, 2026 (Fri)
- C. Required Documents: Must meet one of the following criteria: ①, ②, or ③
 - ① If the applicant is the Financial Guarantor, self-financing the cost of study:
 - Submit an original bank certificate of the deposit balance (in English) showing an amount of at least 16,000,000 Korean won in the applicant's name.
 - ② If the Financial Guarantor is a parent:
 - Submit an original bank certificate of deposit balance (in English) showing an amount of at least 16,000,000 Korean won in a parent's name.
 - Employment Certificate (Original) or Business Registration Certificate (copy) from a parent
 - ※ Brothers and sisters can be guarantors only in cases of the parents' absence.
 - ③ Scholarship Certificate from another organization: If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization
 - ※ If the total amount of scholarship or support funds is less than 16,000,000 Korean won, the applicant will need to submit an original bank certificate of deposit balance for the remaining amount, as required per ① or ②.

※ Notes

1. Certificates without an expiration date must be issued within one month of submission.
2. Certificates with an expiration date must be valid until at least [August 31, 2026](#)
3. Documents in other languages must be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
4. Applicants with Uzbek nationality: Only bank certificates of deposit balance issued by KDB Bank located in Uzbekistan can be submitted.
5. In the case of submitting financial documents by mail, only those postmarked by the post office no later than [June 19, 2026 (Fri)] will be accepted as submitted.

3. Degree Verification Documents

- A. Relevant Applicants: 'Prospective Graduates' who did not submit verification documents at the time of application
 - ※ Applicants who have already graduated must submit academic verification documents by the application deadline.
 - B. Submission Period: by August 28, 2026 (Fri)

 2. Failure to submit degree verification documents may result in the cancellation of admission.

7 Application Fee

 - B. If the Application Fee is not paid within the Application Period, the application will be canceled.
 - C. You will receive an Application Number after the Application Fee has been paid.
 - ※ Note: It is not possible to revise the application contents after the Application Fee has been paid.
3. Refund Policy: Once the payment is completed, the application cannot be canceled, and the application fee is non-refundable.

8 Important Notes for Applicants

1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages must be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, your application will be canceled.
3. Notices related to the admissions process will be sent to the applicant's email address entered on the Application Form, so applicants should check their email regularly after submitting their application. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for application cancellations due to incorrect contact information (email, phone number, etc.), or due to not checking emails.
4. If an applicant's visa is not issued, or is rejected, then their admission will be canceled.
5. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than 16,000,000 Korean won from another institution are not required to submit a Certificate of Financial Guarantee; however, they must submit a Certificate/Letter of Confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at KNU.
6. No submitted documents will be returned to the applicant. (Note: Original documents will be returned after the screening process is completed.)
7. If applicants do not have sufficient academic ability, they may not be selected.
8. According to the regulations for Recognition of Graduation Qualification at KNU, international undergraduate students (excluding transfer students) who are enrolled at KNU must have a "TOPIK" certificate for Level 4 or higher before graduation.
 ※ Only grades within four years from the test date written on the TOPIK certificate are recognized.
9. International students who are admitted to, or already enrolled at, KNU must have Korean health insurance. According to the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Decree, international students who stay in Korea for more than 6 months must have National Health Insurance (국민건강보험) while in Korea.
10. Applicants already residing in Korea who receive admission from KNU must apply for a Change of Visa Status (D-2-2) before the semester begins (August 31, 2026). We strongly recommend checking with the Immigration Office in person to first determine whether it is possible to change one's visa status to D-2-2 in Korea after being admitted to KNU. (Call the Korea Immigration Service: ☎ 1345, without an area code)
11. Further details, if not stated in this Guide, will be in accordance with the Office of International Affairs at KNU.
12. These Admission Guidelines were originally written in Korean and translated into English, Chinese, Japanese, and Vietnamese. Should there be any discrepancies between them, the Korean version supercedes all translated versions.

Scholarships for Newly admitted · Transfer Students

1. TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Scholarships for New Students

- A. TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Level 3 Certificate: Scholarship for 16~20% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
- B. TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Level 4 Certificate: Scholarship for 40~42% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
- C. TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Level 5 Certificate: Scholarship for 80~84% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.
- D. TOPIK (TOPIK IBT) Level 6 Certificate: Scholarship for 100% of the Tuition Fee for the first semester.

2. Scholarships for students who complete 2 semesters of the KNU Korean Language Program

1 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification of public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

※ **NOTE:** Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

- ① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted together with an “Apostille” attachment.
- ② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates; then, the certificates should be submitted together with an “Apostille” attachment.

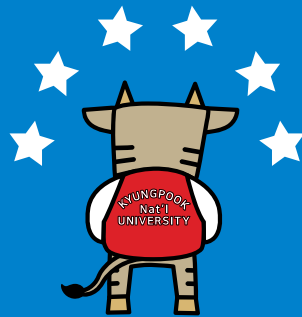

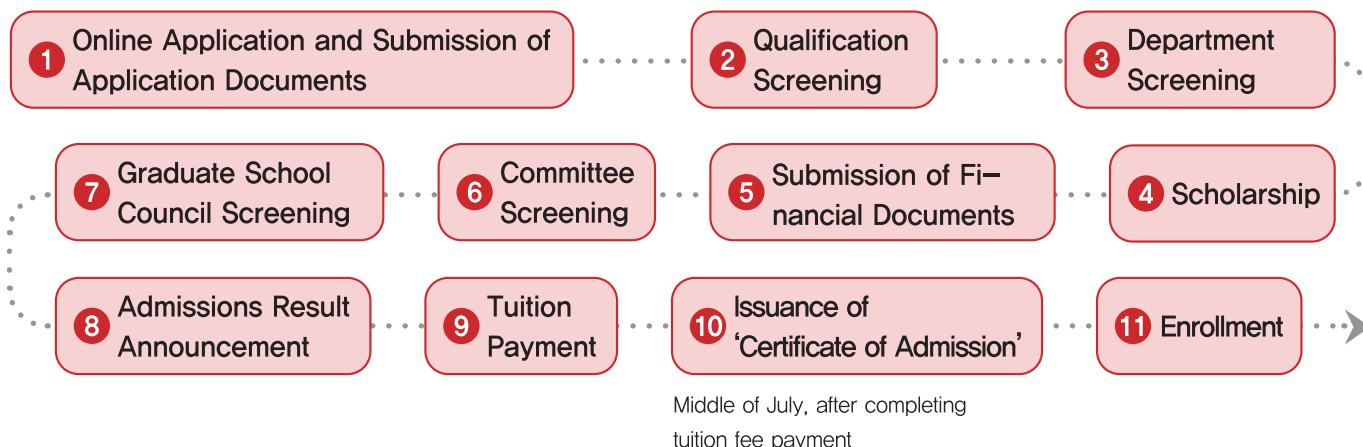

B. Applicants of Korean origin (entire education completed abroad) must meet all of the following requirements:

- ① Holds (or is about to hold) a Master's degree
- ② Received their entire elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate education outside of Korea at a comparable and equivalent level to that provided in Korea.
- ③ Must be a non-Korean national.

3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency

A. Applicants who want to apply for the following departments MUST meet required conditions:

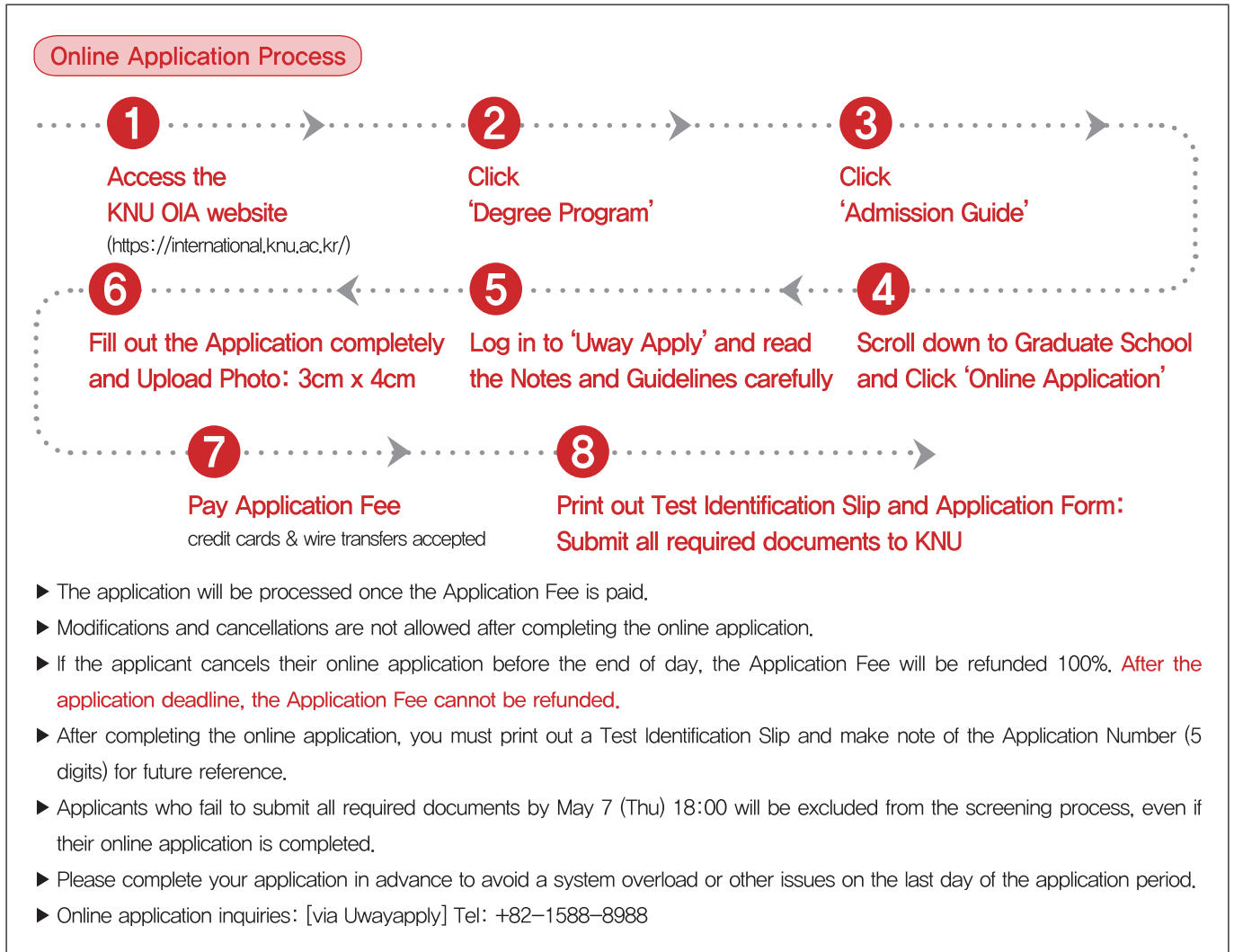

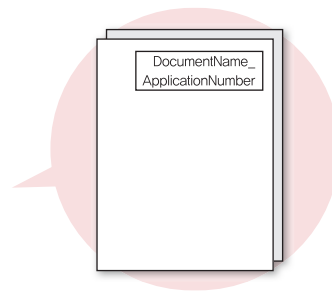

- * If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization. If the total amount of scholarship is insufficient for KRW 16 million, an additional financial guarantee for the shortfall is required.
- * If an academic advisor is serving as the the financial guarantor, the academic advisor's Certificate of Financial Support and his/her Employment Certificate can be substituted for the above documents. (The official KNU format will be provided to academic advisors directly upon request, and should be submitted directly from the academic advisors to the KNU OIA.)

3. Academic Degree Verification Documents

A. For whom: Among the final successful applicants, those who graduated from a university located overseas, not in Korea, and did not submit academic verification documents in application period.

B. Submission Period: by August 28, 2026 (Fri)

C. Required Documents: Successful applicants must submit one of the following documents:

① Documents confirmed by the China Academic Degree (CHSI) & Graduate Education Development Center (CDGDC) (Only for applicants who hold a degree from universities in China.)

② Apostille Certificate of your previous academic documents

③ Original Documents verified by the Korean Embassy in another country or the Embassy in Korea

- * Simple photocopies or notarized copies of the apostilled (or consular confirmed) documents are NOT accepted. However, a certified true copy issued by the Korean Embassy or a certificate of true copy issued by a government agency that issued the original apostilled document will be accepted.

[Notice]

- 1) Certificate of Admission can be issued after submitting all verification documents stated above.
- 2) Successful applicants who graduated from universities in Korea may submit a copy of their degree instead of a verified copy.
- 3) For successful applicants who have to apply for a visa in their country, please consider the timing of issuance of the academic background confirmation document so that it does not affect the semester classes.

2. Payment Method

- a. Payment must be made through the online application program.

- B. Failure to pay the application fee within the application period will result in automatic cancellation of the application.
- C. After payment of the application fee, an application number will be assigned and the application form will be printed. The application will be considered complete. Modifications to the application form will not be permitted after payment has been completed.
- 3. Applications cannot be cancelled after payment has been completed, and the application fee is non-refundable.**

8 Important Notes for Applicants

1. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, the applicant's admission will be cancelled.
2. If the contact information is incorrectly provided on the application, resulting in failure to receive notifications, the applicant will be fully responsible for any consequences, including the cancellation of admission.
3. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her admission will be cancelled.
4. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than 16 million KRW from another institution are not required to submit a Certificate of Financial Guarantee; however, they must submit a Certificate/Letter of Confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at Kyungpook National University.
5. Application Fees and submitted documents will not be returned.
6. As many applications will be expected on the last day of online application, please complete the application as soon as possible before the deadline.
7. As the Application Number is frequently used during the application process, be sure to make note of it separately when submitting the application.
8. If an applicant does not have sufficient academic ability, he or she may not be selected.
9. International students who are admitted to the university or enrolled at KNU must have Korean health insurance. According to the National Health Insurance Act and its Enforcement Decree, from March 1, 2021, international students who stay in Korea for more than 6 months must have National Health Insurance (국민건강보험) in Korea.
10. Further details, if not stated in this Guide, will be in accordance with the KNU Office of International Affairs. These Admissions Guidelines were originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. Should there be any discrepancies between them, the Korean version supercedes all translated versions.
11. The governing language of this Admissions Guide shall be Korean if a misinterpretation should arise.

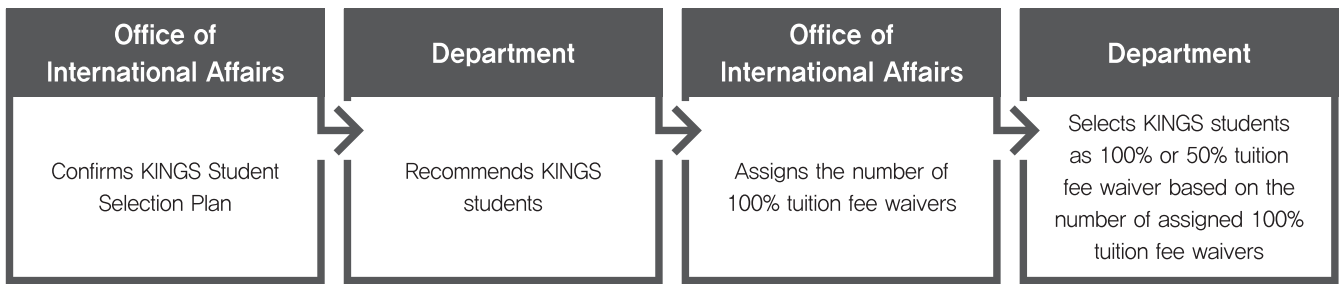

1 Performance Test for Admissions into the Department of Music

- The Departmental Assessment (Student Ability Test) for the Department of Music is a performance test, and applicants must prepare their test pieces (see below) and perform them in person. (The Department will notify applicants of the test schedule after the eligibility check period.)
- If an applicant is not residing in Korea during the Departmental Assessment Period, one may submit a video recording of a musical performance of one’s test piece. However, one can only submit a video that was recorded during the application period. For composition majors, applicants must submit the score of the composition they created as part of the examination.
- In cases where the submitted video is fake or forged in any way, the applicant’s permission for admission can be revoked.
- For applicants to the music theory major who are not residing in Korea, the Department Screening will be scheduled separately and announced accordingly.

2 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification of public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille designation ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

※ **NOTE** : Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

- ① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
- ② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates; then, the certificates should be submitted together with an "Apostille" attachment.
