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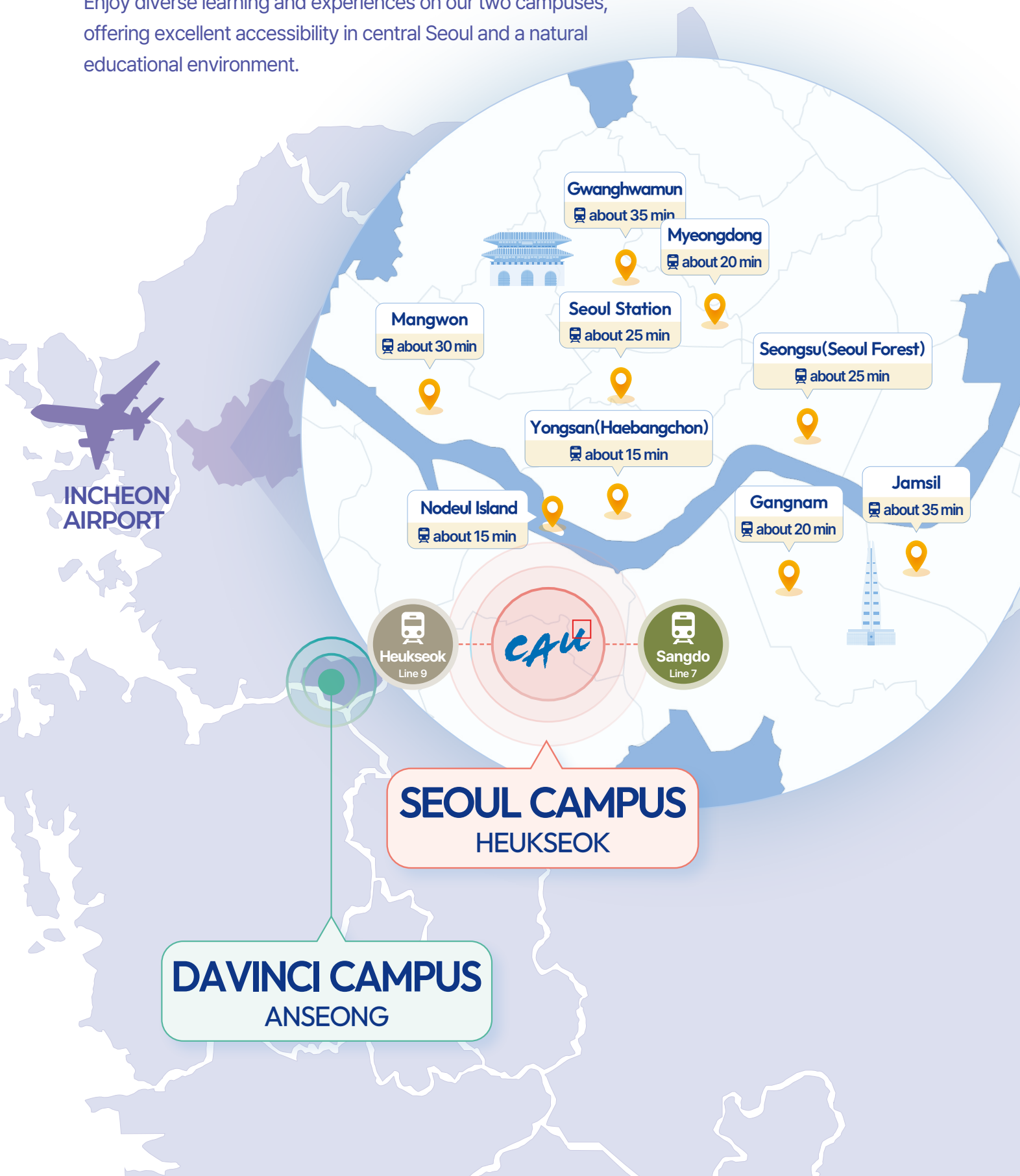

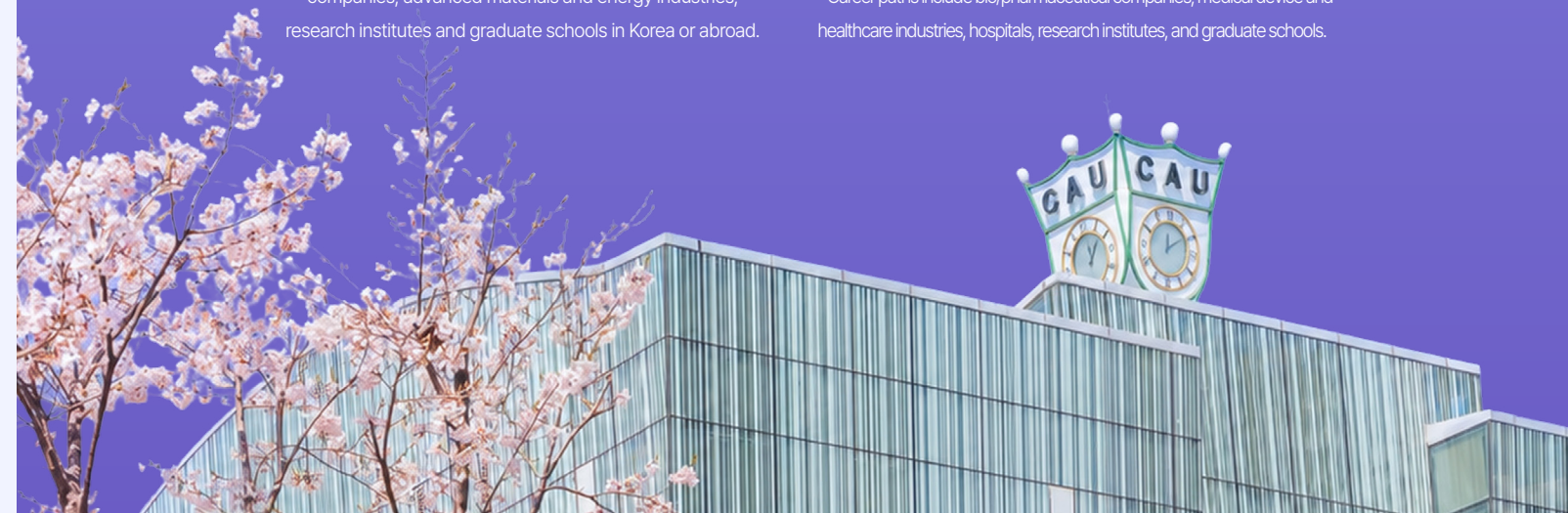

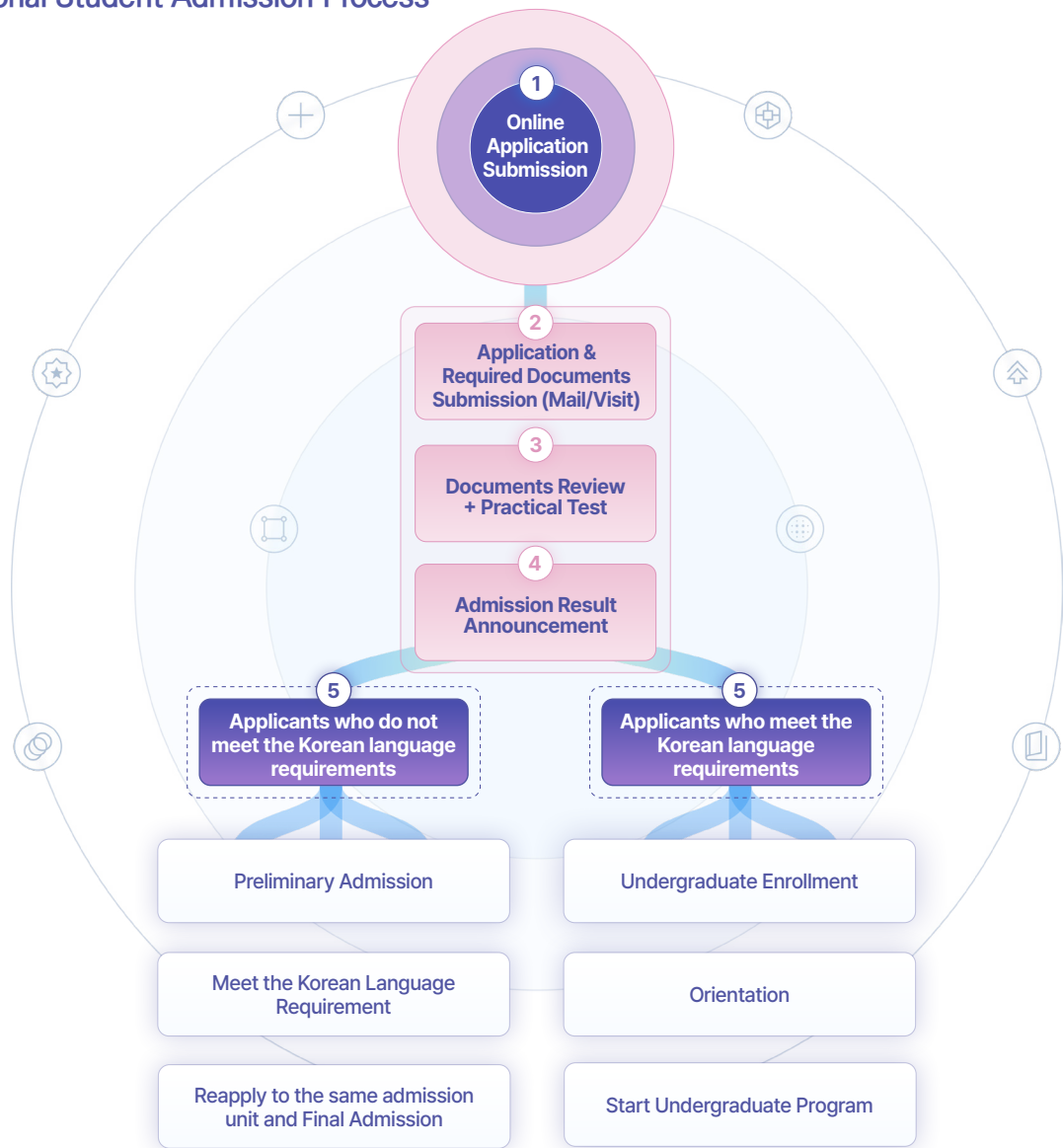

International Student Admission Process



Preliminary Admission System

- Applicants who do not meet the Korean-language requirement may apply. Those found academically eligible to study at CAU through document evaluation and eligibility review will be selected for preliminary admission and issued a Certificate of Preliminary Admission.
- Applicants will be finally admitted if they meet the Korean-language requirement within two years and reapply to the same admission unit.
 - For preliminary admission in Spring 2027, the applicant must meet the Korean-language requirement and reapply no later than Spring 2029.
 - Requirement: **TOPIK Level 4 or higher**, or **completion of Level 4 or higher at the CAU Institute of International Education Korean Language Program**

※ Important Notes for Applicants

- Applicants will not receive individual notice of the provisions in this guide. Applicants must read and understand the guide before applying and are responsible for any disadvantage arising from failure to do so.
- Admission scores and evaluation details will not be disclosed.
- Matters not specified in this guide will be determined by the CAU Undergraduate International Admissions Committee.
- Admitted applicants must complete registration within the designated period. Failure to register by the deadline will result in cancellation of admission.
- Applicants who have registered at CAU may not register simultaneously at another university. They must withdraw from one institution and ultimately register at only one university.
- Admission may be revoked if visa requirements are not met or a visa is denied. Tuition already paid will be refunded in accordance with CAU regulations.
- Applicants who fail to submit documents, provide false information, forge or alter documents, take examinations by proxy, commit other misconduct, or fail to meet eligibility requirements will be disqualified regardless of scores. Admission may be revoked even after enrollment.

 - 1) Both the applicant and parents must have acquired foreign nationality before the applicant began an educational curriculum equivalent to the Korean high-school curriculum. Documents stating the date of acquisition are required.
 - 2) Both the applicant and parents must have renounced or lost Korean nationality before the applicant began a curriculum equivalent to the Korean high-school curriculum.(Submit a certificate of renunciation/loss stating the details and date.)
- An applicant or parent holding multiple nationalities including Korean nationality is not recognized as a foreign national.
- If there are special circumstances concerning family relations or nationality (death, divorce, remarriage, unmarried parents, disappearance, etc.)
 - official supporting documents must be submitted, such as a death certificate, divorce certificate, single-parent certificate, or missing-person certificate.

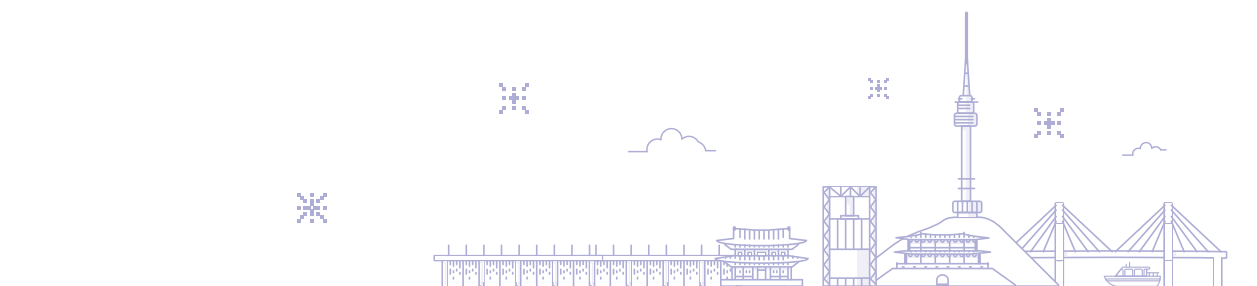
Step 1) Find CAU faculty members in the field of your interest as candidates for your future academic advisor. Applications will not be accepted without the recommendation letter by one of Chung-Ang University full time faculty members as a prospective supervisor.

Step 2) Contact the faculty members directly via email to get a recommendation with as much of your academic background and application information as possible.

Step 3) Chung-Ang University Professor will send the CAYSS recommendation letter to CAU Office of International Affairs directly.

Step 4) CAU Office of International Affairs will send the CAYSS application guide to the recommended students only.

Step 5) Applicant must send by post a set of documents and recommendation letters directly to CAU International Office within the application period. Recommendation letters must be sealed and signed by a professor from the previous university.



3) Important Notice

- Cancellation: If you would like to cancel your study at Chung-Ang University after the semester starts, your scholarship will be canceled and you may be requested to pay a certain amount of tuition fee based on the date and university tuition fee payment policy.
 - CAYSS Scholars cannot take a leave of absence for their first semester as a full scholarship recipient.
 - For CAYSS scholarship students, submission of financial documents proving the ability to cover living expenses is required for visa issuance and the application for the Certificate of Admission.
 - Standard amount for living expenses: 15,000,000 KRW
 - Required deposit amount: Calculated by subtracting the annual research stipend provided by the academic advisor from the standard living expenses.

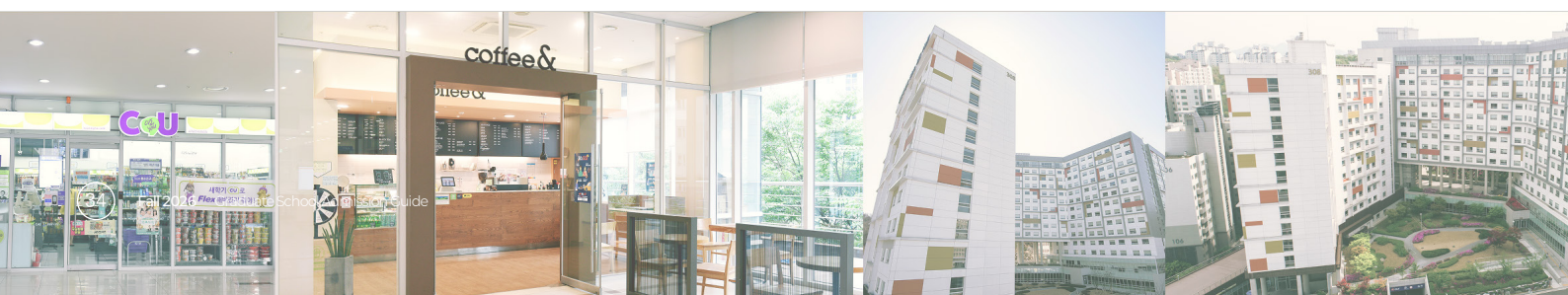

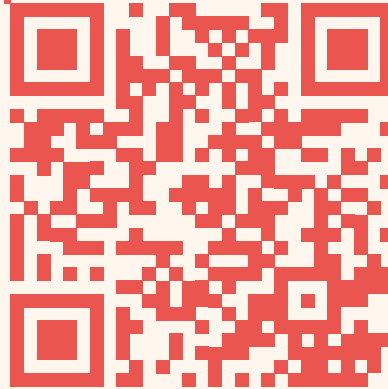
