2. Assessment Method

From the Spring 2027 admissions, applicants will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Application Review (100%)
- College of Music, College of Fine Arts, School of Dance (Seoul Campus), and College of Art and Design (Global Campus): Application Review (50%) + Practical Test (50%)

3. Document Submission

From the Spring 2027 admissions, all required documents must be submitted by post. In-person submission will not be accepted. Please check the document submission deadline and ensure that all required documents are received by the deadline. The University is not responsible for documents received after the submission deadline.

4. Required Documents

From the Spring 2027 admissions, some required documents have been revised. Please review the required documents and evaluation criteria before submitting your application materials.

Kyung Hee University was founded in 1949 with the intention of "Creating a Civilized World." Since its establishment, Kyung Hee has followed a tradition combining academic and practical achievement, the pursuit of universal values and harmony. In 1965, the International Association of University Presidents (IAUP) was established, and its subsequent activities include contributions to the UN International Day of Peace in 1981. Kyung Hee's three campuses (Seoul, Global, and Gwangneung) are part of a comprehensive and future-oriented academic system. As of 2025, the University has 25,573 undergraduate students, 8,769 graduate students, and 1,395 full-time faculty members, and is composed of 23 colleges and 88 departments (majors). TOPIK Encouragement Scholarship

Awarded to students who have obtained TOPIK Level 4 or higher, or have achieved an improvement in their TOPIK level. KRW 500,000 per semester, up to 3 semesters) career planning.

Academic Encouragement Scholarship

Awarded to selected honor students among applicants with a minimum 3.0 GPA from the previous semester((KRW 500,000~4,000,000 awarded based on GPA))in new and unfamiliar environments.

Academic Improvement Scholarship

Awarded to International students who show significant academic improvement compared Korean and English.

KHU-PASS Certification Scholarship

Awarded to students who obtain final certification under the KHU-PASS Core Competency Certification Programme, along with an official certificate and digital open badges (KRW 500,000)

KHU Institute of International Education (IIE) Special Course Tuition Refund Scholarship

Awarded upon completion of special courses, such as online Korean language courses offered by the IIE, with a full tuition refund.

KHU-PASS Core Competency Certification Programme

“An Official System Certifying the Growth of International Students”

KHU-PASS(Kyung Hee University – Pathway for Academic & Social Success) is Kyung Hee University's core competency certification programme that records and certifies international students' academic, global, career, and employment-related activities as a single, integrated pathway of growth. All efforts accumulated during enrolment are formally recognised through digital open badges, official certificates, and scholarships.

Upon completion of the programme, digital open badges are issued for each core competency and may be used as official records of achievement in CVs, portfolios, and other professional materials.

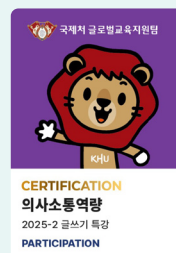

- Department of History applicants (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in history or related major at a 4-year university
- Department of Sociology (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in a social science at a 4-year university
- Department of International Business and Trade (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in Trade, Business Administration, Economics, or Statistics at a 4-year university
- Department of Economics (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in economics, business administration, mathematics or statistics at a 4-year university
- Department of Chemistry (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in Chemistry at a 4 year university
- College of Fine Arts (Transfer): Applicants must have majored in Art at their previous university.

※ From the 2nd year onwards, students in the following colleges/schools can freely choose their desired major/department

- Division of Management and Accounting: Students may choose between the Department of Business Administration and the Department of Accounting (excluding the Department of Big Data Analytics in the College of Management).
- School of Tourism and Entertainment: Students may choose between the Department of Tourism Science and the Department of Culture and Entertainment.

* Students admitted to the Department of Global Eminence will take courses exclusively for international students. Upon selecting a major in their 2nd year, students who have obtained TOPIK Level 4 may freely choose any major/department offered at the Seoul Campus, regardless of their division. (The Global Business major, which is exclusively for international students, is open for application regardless of TOPIK level.) [Excluding Department of Premedical course, Department of Pre-Korean Medicine, Department of Premedical course for Dentistry, Department of Pharmaceutical Science, Department of Oriental Pharmacy, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Department of Nursing, Department of Future Information Display, Department of Big Data Analytics, Global Leader, College of Music, School of Dance, College of Fine Arts, as well as the Admission Unit for employed graduates of specialized high schools]

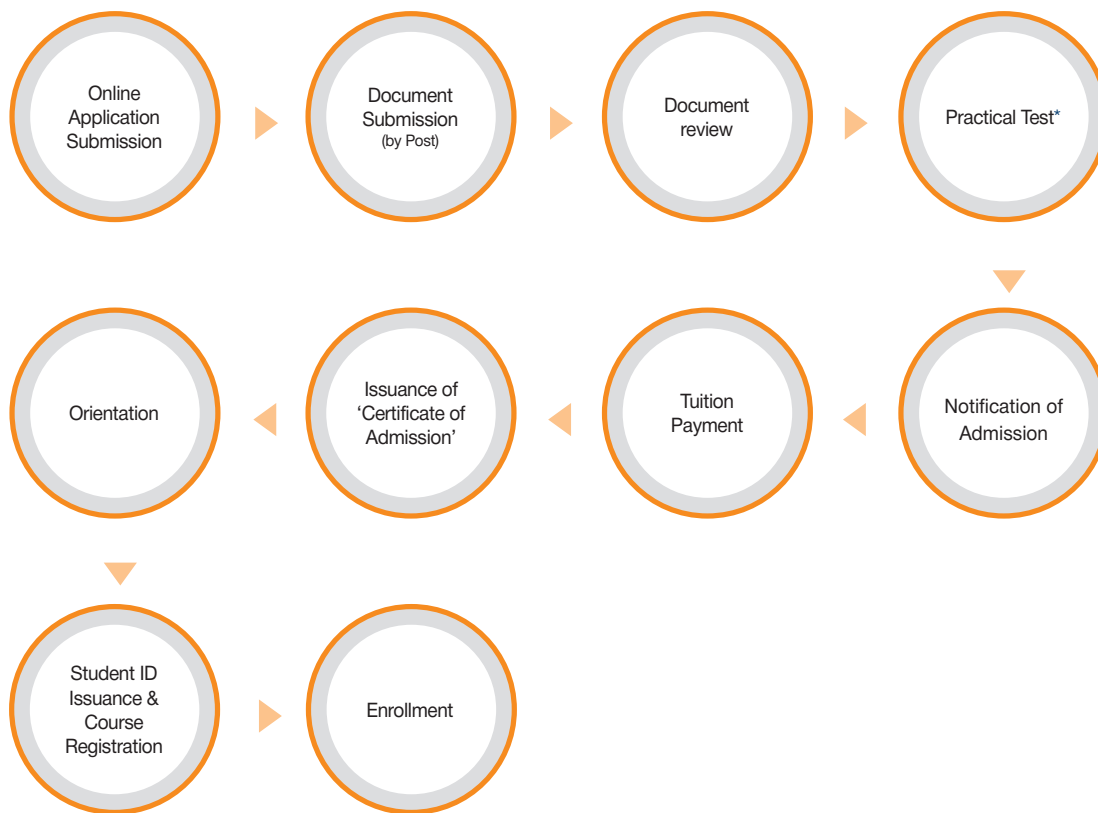
- College of Liberal Studies: Students may freely choose any undergraduate program available at the Global Campus (excluding the Department of Postmodern Music).

※ Department of Chinese: Applicants of Chinese nationality are not eligible to apply. However, applicants who graduated from a high school in Korea are eligible to apply. (Applicants who graduated from a Korean high school and have been enrolled in a Chinese university are eligible to apply, whereas applicants who graduated from a Chinese high school and have been enrolled in a Korean university are not eligible to apply.)

※ For freshmen and transfer students admitted in the 2026 academic year and thereafter, completion of at least one of the following three programs is required for graduation: multiple major, minor, or Micro Degree. [Excluding students in the College of Medicine, College of Nursing Science, and College of Pharmacy, except for the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences.]

2. Admission Process

a. Admission Process



※ KHU Korean Language Test: In lieu of the TOPIK Korean Language test, qualified applicants can fulfil the Korean Language requirement through the KHU Language exam.

※ *1st intake: Department of Postmodern Music, 2nd intake: College of Music, School of Dance, College of Fine Arts, Department of Postmodern Music

Test Schedule

- KHU Korean Language Test (August): August 22nd, 2026(Sat)

- KHU Korean Language Test (October): October 17th, 2026(Sat)

b. Submission of Application

- Admission application forms are **ONLY** available and accepted online.

- 1 Access the website at <<http://www.khu.ac.kr>> and then click on “Links”, followed by “Spring 2027 International Undergraduate Admission Application.”
- 2 Register and log in.
- 3 Read the important notes and guidelines carefully.
- 4 Fill out the application completely and save.
- 5 Upload a passport-sized photo.
- 6 Review application thoroughly.
- 7 Make application fee payment.(Credit cards or wire transfers)
- 8 Print out application and miscellaneous documents.
- 9 Submit all the application materials (refer to appendix 1) within the designated period to **the Division of Global Admissions (Seoul Campus)**

- 1) Applicants may submit an application for only one campus - please choose either the Seoul Campus or the Global Campus.
- 2) Online applications must be submitted by 17:00 (UTC +9:00 Seoul Standard) on the last day for submission. Please submit your application before the last days as the online system may be delayed due to the high volume of online traffic. **After the application deadline, the application fee is non-refundable. (Based on Article 42-3 (Admission Fee) of the Higher Education Act Enforcement Decree).**
- 3) The application fee must be paid in order for the online application to be printed. The application cannot be changed after the application fee is paid. **After the application deadline, it is not possible to modify the application unit (major), application type (freshmen/transfer), or cancel the application, so please complete the application with caution.**
- 4) Any applicant who falsifies information, fails to submit materials on time, or cannot be contacted by the school will be disqualified from admission review. Meeting the outlined criteria and deadlines is entirely the responsibility of the applicant, and KHU will not consider an objection to disqualification (Application fee is not refundable).
- 5) Application fee: KRW 180,000
 - College of Music, School of Dance, College of Fine Arts (Seoul Campus), Department of Post Modern Music (Global Campus)
 - ⇒ KRW 250,000

3. Eligibility

a. Freshman

Eligibility

1. Nationality Requirement: Applicants and both of their parents must be non-Korean citizens and must meet all the following conditions:

- a) Both the applicant and both their parents must have non-Korean citizenship prior to the applicant beginning high school/secondary school (or equivalent to the level of Korean high school). Applicants whose nationality was originally Korean but changed after the beginning of high school are not qualified to apply to the international admission.
- b) If an applicant's parents abandoned (or lost) their Korean citizenship, the applicant must submit proof of denationalization (loss of nationality)
- c) If the applicant's legal support obligator is one of applicant's parents, only the nationality of the person liable for support shall be considered for the application qualification (However, it must be proved by government - issued document) In case of divorce of parents, please refer to the 'Eligibility for both Freshmen and Transfer students' listed below.
- ※ If the above does not apply, please contact us individually.

2. Academic Requirement

- a) Applicants must have completed or be expected to have completed secondary education prior to admission
- b) Department of Big Data Analytics (College of Management) : Applicants must meet the following conditions:
 - Applicants must be ranked within the top 10% of their high school class.
 - Applicants must have an average percentile of 90 or above in mathematics courses throughout all years of high school.
 - ※ Applicants whose school records include any notation related to school violence are not eligible to apply.

3. Language Requirement(Korean Track): Applicants must meet one of the following conditions:

- a) Obtained TOPIK Level 3 or above (TOPIK iBT is acceptable except trial tests.)
 - The score must be valid at the time of application
- b) Enrolled in and completed Intermediate 2 Korean Language Course through KHU-affiliated language institutes (Applicants must have completed the courses less than 2 years from the beginning date of the online application)
- c) Passed level 3 of the KHU Korean Language Test (The score valid at the time of application)
- d) Korea Immigration and Integration Program level 3 or above (or obtain 61 score or higher at the Pre-test)
- e) King Sejong Institute Korean Language Intermediate level 1 or above (Practical program and online program are not acceptable)
- f) Graduates(prospective graduates) of Korean high schools who are recognized to have sufficient Korean language skills(International schools and Foreign schools are not acceptable)
- g) Department of Global Eminence(Seoul Campus): Applicants who hold a TOPIK score or are deemed to have an equivalent level of Korean language proficiency.
- h) Department of Big Data Analytics (Seoul Campus) : Obtained TOPIK Level 6
- ※ KHU Korean Language Test: details can be found at 'KHU Korean Language Test'
- ※ The terms of enrollment and issuance visa are subject to change according to Korean government policies. It will be notified separately.

4. Language Requirement(English Track): Applicants must meet one of the following conditions:

- a) Hold a citizenship of an English-speaking country or a country where English is an official language
- b) Obtain an official English proficiency test. (The score must be TOEFL iBT 80 (4.0 for tests taken on/after Jan. 21, 2026), IELTS 6.0, or NEW TEPS 327 or higher)(The expiration date should be after the starting date of the online application. IELTS scores are valid for two years from the test date stated on the official score report.)
- c) completed secondary education (high school) in a country where English is the native or official language.
- ※ The terms of enrollment and issuance of visa are subject to change according to Korean government policy. It will be notified separately.
- d) Departments: Department of Management, Department of Global Hospitality & Tourism Management, Department of International Studies, Department of Asian Studies

※ Applicants satisfying the academic requirements for transfer (graduation from a two or three-year community college or having completed at least two years and earned at least 1/2 of the credits required for a bachelor's degree at a four-year college or university) are also eligible to apply for freshmen admission.

※ Eligibility for both Freshmen and Transfer students as long as the academic accreditation for primary and secondary education is eligible.

1. KHU students (whether enrolled or on leave of absence) are not eligible to apply

2. Korean citizens (including the applicant and their parents) are prohibited from applying for international undergraduate admission.

- Applicants whose families are of Korean origin must submit proof of denationalization or loss of nationality (verified by official government-issued documents)

3. Only accredited primary, middle, high schools and international equivalent degrees can be accepted for admission - GEDs (General Equivalency Diploma), homeschooling, online education, lifelong learning, adult education and other certificates are not eligible for the international admission.

※ Korean secondary educational institutions can be accepted if the institution attains the educational credential by the Korean Ministry of Education. However, applicants who completed secondary education from foreign schools or foreign secondary education institutions located in Korea, can be accepted if the school is established by the regulation of the Korean Ministry of Education. Additional documents are required below.

- Certificate of accreditation by the local education office

- Documents certifying that the applicant completed all primary & secondary education in accordance with Korean primary & secondary education system(e.g. certificate of graduation of primary & secondary education institutions)

- If the applicant enrolled more than two schools with different school system or skipped a grade which cause any loss in semester, a document proving the system difference or grade skipping is required.

4. b. Transfer

Eligibility

1. Nationality Requirement: Applicants and both of his/her parents must be non-Korean citizens and must meet all the following conditions:

- a) Both the applicant and both their parents must have non-Korean citizenship prior to the applicant beginning high school/secondary school (or equivalent to the level of Korean high school). Applicants whose nationality was originally Korean but changed after the beginning of high school are not qualified to apply to the international admission.
- b) If an applicant oneself and whose parents abandoned (or lost) their Korean citizenship, the applicant must submit proof of denationalization (loss of nationality).

5) Applicants who do not comply with admissions guidelines or fail to submit all required documents will be disqualified from the process, and contents not included in this guideline will comply with the international student admission policy at Kyung Hee University. 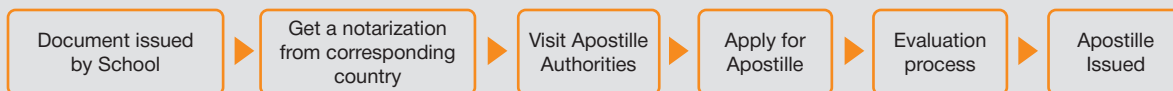

- ⑪ Applicants may be asked to submit additional documents in addition to already specified documents in Admissions Guideline in purpose of confirmation about the applying eligibility, etc.
- ⑫ If any reasons for disqualification, such as ineligibility for application, are found as a result of review of the submitted documents, the application will be excluded from the screening process and the application fee will not be refunded.
- ⑬ If, even after being selected as successful applicants, false information is found in the submitted documents or qualification conditions that violate the school rules are discovered, (e.g., if the degree obtained during the degree verification process through academic background inquiry is found to be false) the admission and registration will be revoked even after the class starts.

⑭ Final successful candidates must verify whether the country where their school is located is a member of the Apostille Convention when obtaining consular confirmation or Apostille certification for their final academic documents.

- If the country is a member of the Apostille Convention, an Apostille certification must be obtained from the government of that country
- If the country is not a member, consular confirmation must be obtained from the Korean diplomatic mission in that country

Please note that after admission, during the issuance process of the Certificate of Admission, the visa application, and the review of immigration status, the Ministry of Justice or the Korean Embassy may request apostilled documents in addition.

13. Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Is there any entrance scholarship for international students?

- A1. Yes, we provide scholarships for international students that is decided upon admission such as President's Scholarship (Thesis Submission Scholarship for International Students) [Seoul Campus] / President's Scholarship (International Students) [Global Campus]. Other on-campus and off-campus scholarships from foundations and institutions are also available.

Q2. In case of Chinese University graduates, what kind of documents should be submitted?

- A2. You must submit all of the following documents:
- Online Verification Report of Higher Education Qualification Certificate AND Online Verification Report of Higher Education Degree Certificate, total of two documents. (one for each) All documents must be in English.
 - * Refer to Chinese Ministry of Education (www.chsi.com.cn)
 - A copy of a Degree Certificate AND Graduation Certificate issued by school, total of two documents(one for each).

Q3. What kind of documents should be submitted for applicants who are expected to graduate?

- A3. Prospective Graduates must submit appropriate documents regarding to the location of graduated institutions. Successful Applicants must submit the original final graduation certificate, degree certificate and transcript (All translated and notarized, then authenticated by Korean Embassy or Apostilled) after result announcement, before the due date of 2027.02.17.(Wed.). To fail submit documents will lead to cancellation of admission.

Q4. What is the interview process?

- A4. ① Check if your applying department has interview process on the Admissions Guideline.
② Interview time and location will be announced on the website of Global Admissions Team (<http://iadmission.khu.ac.kr>) after 2026.11.26.(Thu.) 15:00 and notifications on online interview log-in process will be notified via email individually.
③ Applicants who fail to attend the required interview or audition will be disqualified.

Q5. Do I have to submit all documents by deadline?

- A5. If applicants fail to submit all documents by deadline, they will be excluded from the admission process.

Q6. My undergraduate major and the applying major are different. Can I still apply?

- A6. Yes, you can. However, evaluation for the academic (major) ability will be carried on separately. Applicants must take prerequisite subjects designated by the corresponding department when entering. (9 credits or more for Master's program, 12 credits or more for Ph. D and Combined programs)

Q7. What is the entering procedure after being accepted?

A7. After being accepted, step-by-step entering procedure is as following:

- ① Check the admission results / print out the letter of admission
- ② Print out the tuition invoice during the registration period and make payments to the designated bank account
- ③ Final successful applicants must submit the required documents (refer to the Guidelines for Successful Applicants).
- ④ Check Global Admissions Team website and search for notifications related to "How to Apply for Certificate of Admission" – follow the procedure and apply for Certificate of Admission personally
- ⑤ Receive your "Certificate of Admission" (scanned copy will be delivered to your e-mail inbox)
- ⑥ Apply for visa: Prepare required documents, complete the application and submit to relevant agency:
 - ㉠ If you are residing in Korea: Immigration Office
 - ㉡ If you are residing outside of Korea: Local Korean Embassy
- ⑦ Course Registration
- ⑧ Orientation
- ⑨ Semester begins

Q8. How can students residing outside of Korea pay the tuition fee?

A8. Applicants who reside overseas must pay the tuition fee via virtual payment account specified in the tuition invoice. All extra fees for international wire transfer is on applicants. The swift code of KEB HANA bank is KOEXKRSE.

Q9. Is there any additional fee for the recipients of President's Scholarship (Seoul C. and Global C.)?

A9. Yes, the entrance fee will be charged without exception, so check out the tuition invoice and make payments during the designated period.

Q10. I'm an Overseas Korean Foundation Scholarship recipient. Do I need to pay tuition?

A10. OKF scholarship recipients whose tuition is waived(Seoul C.) are required to pay the admission fee. Recipients who receive only the living expenses (stipend) from the foundation must pay both the admission fee and tuition. Also, please submit your Scholarship Certificate to Global Admissions Team.

Q11. Is there an extended period for tuition payment?

A11. Tuition must be paid on time. If failed to do so, admission and enrollment will be canceled.

Q12. Can the Certificate of Admission be reissued?

A12. The Certificate of Admission is issued only once. Please note that it is one of the most important documents when it comes to the visa application process and take extra care not to lose it. Also please be aware that it is not a certificate for allowing admission, but a certificate for issuing visa to enter Korea.

Q13. Is insurance mandatory?

A13. Starting from Mar. 1st 2021, international students are under National Health Insurance, and therefore students have to register without exception.

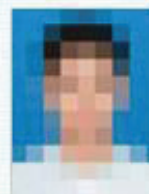

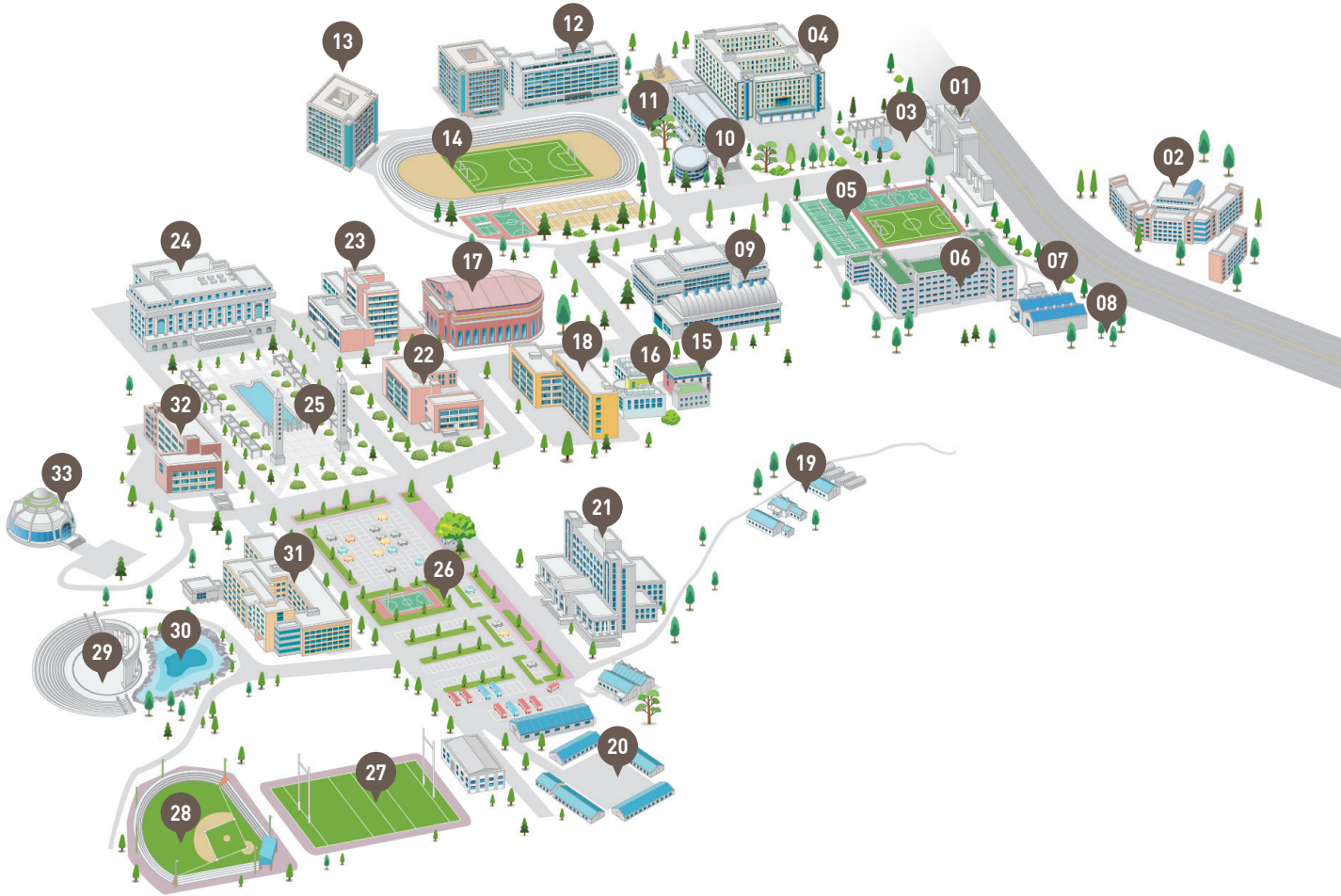
