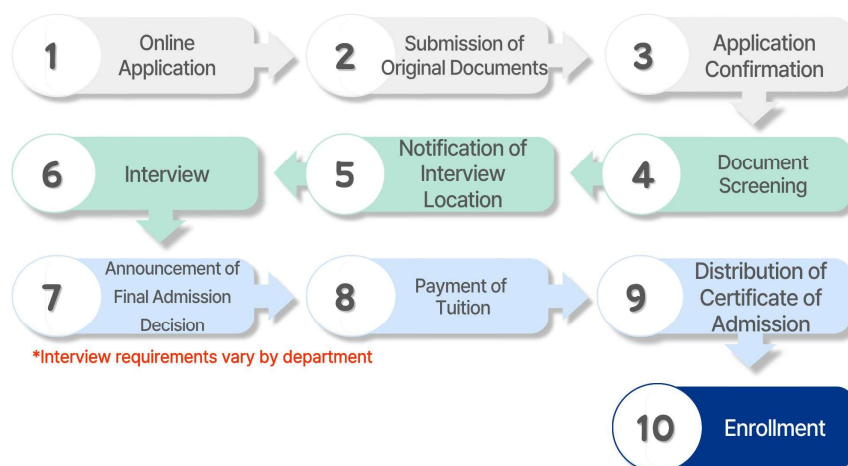

- ※ Most of the courses are taught in Korean. All courses are taught in English by the Department of Global Studies ONLY.
- ※ [MEDICAL SERVICE ACT] (Amended 2012 Feb 1, Enforcement 2017 Feb 2) According to the amendments adopted under Article 5 and Article 7, a person who graduates from a university whose nursing education program has obtained accreditation qualifies for the national examination. Our College of Nursing has obtained accreditation from the Ordinance of the Ministry of Health and Welfare (period: 2021 June 13 ~ 2029 June 12).

3. Qualifications and Required Documents

□ Qualifications

◆ Nationality

Both the applicant and the parents must be foreign nationals

- If the applicant and the parents acquired foreign nationality through emigration or adoption, their acquisition must have been completed before the applicant started the curricula equivalent to Korea's elementary and secondary education in a foreign country (the proof of nationality acquisition is required).
- ※ Korean and dual nationals are not eligible to apply.
- ※ Both the applicant and the parents must complete the renunciation or loss of Korean nationality before the application deadline.
- ※ Ground: 「Enforcement Decree of the Higher Education Act」 Article 29 Paragraph 2 No. 6

◆ Language Proficiency

- ※ Applicant who is studying at PNU Language Education Institute should submit the certificate of enrollment. If the applicant fails to submit language proficiency (completion of PNU LEI) **by Fri, 29th Jan 2027**, preliminary admission shall be canceled.
- ※ **Applicants with Nepalese, Mongolian, Vietnamese, Uzbekistan nationality must have a language proficiency score of TOPIK level 5, IELTS 7, or TOEFL iBT 85(5) or higher, regardless of the department's general language requirements**

A. Valid Documents: Issued within 6 months of the deadline (Nov. 6, Fri 2026).

B. For overseas school (or university) graduation certificates and transcripts, submit verified documents in one of the following ways.

(Except for the official seal of the principal of one of the Korean International Schools authorized by the Minister of Education)

1. Obtaining Apostille stamps on documents (graduation & transcript of high school/university)

※ In cases where the student has attended or graduated from school(s) in a country that is a member of the Hague Convention, see Appendix #3 'Apostille Convention Countries.'

2. Obtaining certification of documents (graduation & transcript of high school/university) from the Korean Embassy or Consular office in the country where the applicant's school is located or from the Embassy of the country where the applicant's school is located in Korea.

3. Only for applicants who receive(d) diploma or academic degree from Chinese high school or universities

- Graduation Certificate:

Submit only the degree verification report issued by the China Higher Education Student Information and Career Center (CHSI, www.chsi.com.cn)(Processing time: approximately 3-4 weeks)

- Academic Transcript:

If issued in Chinese, it must be translated and notarized, then submitted as an APOSTILLE-certified document (海牙认证)

[Reference 3] Certificate of Financial Support and Certificate of Bank Balance

A. Valid Documents: Issued within 30 days of the deadline (Nov. 6, Fri 2026).

B. Certificate of Bank Balance must be one of the following:

- Bank certificate of the balance of KRW 16,000,000 or more in the name of the applicant
 - Bank certificate of the balance of KRW 16,000,000 or more in the name of the applicant's father or mother
 - Certificate of money transfer to Korea or exchange ※ If the balance certificate has an expiration date, it is recognized only until the expiration date.
- ※ If you or your parents (financial sponsor) resides in Korea, proof of funds can only be provided through only bank account in Korea, and it must be submitted regardless of visa type.
- ※ Applicants with Nepal, Mongol, Vietnam, or Uzbekistan nationality will have their admission canceled if additional documents are not submitted or if the specified conditions are not met.

※ Vietnamese applicant:

(In Korea) Applicant must submit a bank balance certificate issued by the NH Bank branch located at Pusan National University, and deposit the same amount **by Dec 18, Fri 2026**. In addition, a transaction history of the same account must be submitted **by Dec 21, Mon 2026** after admission has been confirmed.

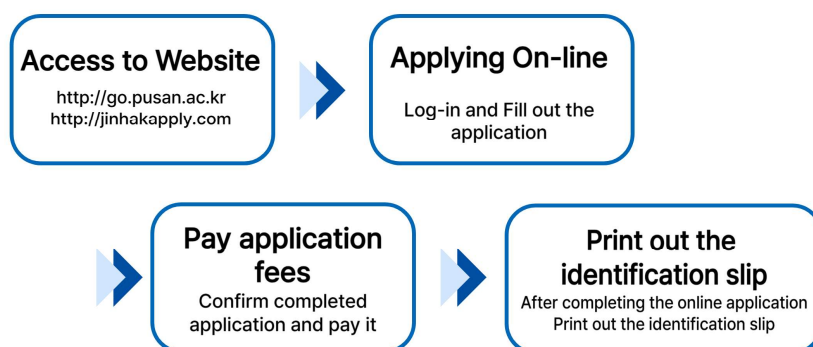

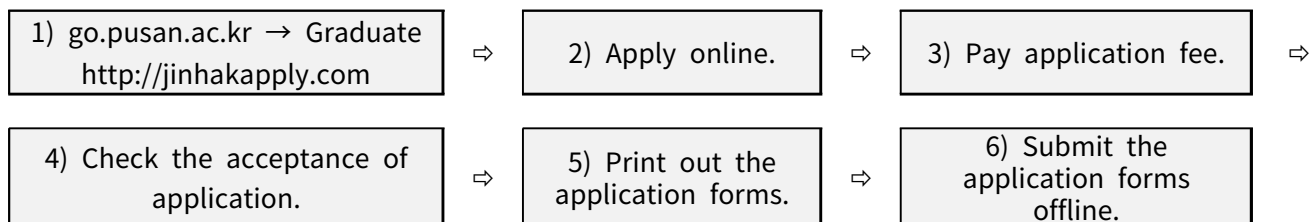
